

SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Applicants for the Master of Arts (Nationhood Studies) must possess:

- i. a Bachelor degree with honours from UUM or any other institution of higher learning recognised by the UUM Senate with a CGPA of at least 2.75; or
- ii. a Bachelor degree from UUM or any other institution of higher learning recognised by the UUM Senate with at least three (3) years of work experience in public or private sectors; and
- iii. Fulfill the English Language requirements.
