PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The Master of Public Administration (MPA), Master of Arts (International Relations), Master of Arts (Political Sciences), and Master of Arts (Sociology) and Master of Science (Tourism and Hospitality Management) are offered by full research. Students have to successfully complete the following:

- i. Pass eight (8) credit hours or 2 courses determined by School (if necessary);
- ii. Attend at least two (2) colloquium sessions;
- iii. Defend a research proposal to a Committee.
 - a) Students must submit two (2) copies of their research proposal to the College/Graduate School at least 2 weeks prior to the proposal defense session;
 - b) The research proposal should cover the following topics:
 - Chapter 1 : Background of the study, problem statement, research questions, research objectives, scope of the study, and significance of the study.
 - Chapter 2 : Literature review
 - Chapter 3 : Research methodology
 - a) Research framework
 - b) Hypotheses/ propositions development
- iv. Attend a **viva** session (oral examination) for the thesis defense; and
- v. Submit the **final thesis**.
