

SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

- i. a Bachelor of Law with honours (LL.B [hons.]) from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia and UUM Senate; and
- ii. Fulfill the English Language requirements.
