

SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Applicants for Master of Law must possess:

- i. a Bachelor of Law with honours (LL.B [hons.]) from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia with a CGPA of at least 2.75; OR
- ii. a Bachelor of Law with honours (LL.B [hons.]) from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia with a work experience of at least 3 years; OR
- iii. a Bachelor of Jurisprudents (B. Juris) from any institution of higher learning recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia with a work experience of at least 5 years;
- iv. a Bachelor of Philosophy, Law and Business (BPLB) from UUM with a CGPA of at least 2.75; OR
- v. a Bachelor of Philosophy, Law and Business (BPLB) from UUM with a work experience of at least 3 years; OR
- vi. any other equivalent qualification recognised by the University Senate; AND
- vii. Fulfill the English Language requirements.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The Master of Law is offered by research. Students have to successfully complete the following:

- i. Pass the following 2 courses (eight (8) credit hours) with at least a B grade :
 - a) GMUP 5014 Legal Research Methodology
 - b) SCLE 6014 Academic Writing
- ii. Attend at least two (2) colloquium sessions;
- iii. Defend a research proposal to a Committee.
 - a) Students must submit two (2) copies of their research proposal to the College/Graduate School at least 2 weeks prior to the proposal defense session;
 - b) The research proposal should cover the following topics:
 - Chapter 1 : Background of the study, problem statement, research questions, research objectives, scope of the study, and significance of the study.
 - Chapter 2 : Literature review
 - Chapter 3 : Research methodology
 - a) Research framework
 - b) Hypotheses/ propositions development
- iv. Attend a **viva** session (oral examination) for the thesis defense; and
- v. Submit the **final thesis**.
