

SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Applicants for Master of Science (Strategic Studies) must possess:

- i. a Bachelor's degree with honours from Universiti Utara Malaysia or any other universities recognised by the UUM Senate with a CGPA of at least 2.75; or
- ii. a Bachelor's degree with at least 3 years of work experience in government or private sectors; or
- iii. any other equivalent qualification recognised by the UUM Senate; and
- iv. Fulfill the English Language requirement.
